• Understanding the choices of vision

- “Vision is the visual manifestation of your *purpose* in life.”
- “Vision is the discovery of God’s *assignment* for your life.”
- “Vision is both personal & corporate.”
- “Every human being is created to fulfil a part of God’s ultimate purpose.”

• Vision both personal & corporate

And the Lord God said, “It is not good that man should be alone...” (Gen 2:18a)

- ‘Alone’ -> ‘All one’ -> ‘Exclusive’ -> ‘Exclude’
- Esther, Joseph, Moses, all had strong personal passion but it had to be attached to a corporate passion.
- Vision clarifies purpose, gives direction, & gives you the capacity to be empowered beyond your assets.
- Vision gives you an assignment that you cannot pay for on your own.

• Vision & the narrow way

“Enter by the narrow gate; for wide is the gate and broad is the way that leads to destruction, and there are many who go in by it. Because narrow is the gate and

confined is the way which leads to life, and there are few who find it. (Matt 7:13-14)

- Wise people make choices that protect their vision.
- Every vision in life has clear restrictions.
- Vision controls;
 1. Your future
 2. Your friends
 3. Who are not your friends (show me your friends and I’ll show you your future)
 4. Your library
 5. How you use your time (you become what you spend your time with)
 6. How to use your energy
 7. How to choose your movies (to survive TV you’ve got to be smart!)
 8. How to choose your priorities
 9. How to choose your hobbies (choose hobbies that take you higher)
 10. Your diet
 11. Your money
 12. Your ‘to do’ list
 13. Your attitude towards life
 14. Your life span
 15. *Everything* in your life
