• Understanding the original sin

- “The greatest enemy of man is his misconception of himself.”
- “Ignorance of self is the root of all of man’s frustrations and the heart of his dilemma.”
- “The foundation of the ultimate temptation was self deception.”
- “The original sin was the result of self doubt.”
- “Satan’s temptation was the temptation of self doubt.”
- “That’s the foundation of our problems, because it is the foundation of sin.”

• The key of truth

And you shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free..
(John 8:32)

- The truth about you is the key to personal freedom.
- Satan’s greatest weapon against you is to maintain your ignorance of your self.
- If you ever discover the truth about you, you become free from satan’s lie about you.
- There are many things that people look to, to make them free, but Jesus said there is only *one thing* that will make you free.
- He said you shall know something...you shall know the truth & the truth shall make you free.

• Your bondage is a lie!

But I fear, lest somehow, as the serpent deceived Eve by his craftiness, so your minds may be corrupted from the simplicity that is in Christ.
(2 Cor. 11:3)

- There is a lie that is keeping every human in bondage, and the only way to break the lie is with the key of truth.
- The lie is about *who you are*.
- Man's ignorance of his true identity, his self worth, his intrinsic value, his abilities & his purpose in life, is the heart of all his problems.

• It is written...

I said, “You are gods (elohim, mighty ones), and all of you are children of the Most High. But you shall die like men, and fall like one of the princes.”
(Psa. 82:6-7)

- Psalm 82 affirms that we have been created in the very image of God (Elohim)
- It is also a warning to those who walk around in ignorance of who they are.
- “...you shall die like men (mere flesh, like the animal kingdom).
- ‘They walk about in darkness’ (ignorance); *verse 5b*
- “...and fall like one of the princes (satan).”
- Satan was never created in the class of man, he was only a cherub, but he wants to dominate man through ignorance & religious ideas!
