



## Powermaxx PowerPoint 21 – “I’m too Valuable!” (part two)

- “I’m too valuable to be ruled by my physical senses”

*Then the eyes of both of them were opened, and they knew that they were naked; and they sewed fig leaves together and made themselves coverings.*

*(Gen 3:7)*

- Gen 3:7 marks the birth of **education** as we know it today.
- Fallen man now became aware of the **‘sense’** realm.
- Before the fall, man lived by **discernment**.
- After the fall, man being spiritually dead, was now dominated by his **five physical senses**.
- Man’s soul (mind, will, & emotions) was now subject to the flesh life. He was now ‘under new management’, and **dominated**.

- “God valued me too much to leave me in slavery”

*Therefore if any person is [Ingrafted] in Christ (the Messiah) he is a new creation (a new creature altogether); the old [previous moral and spiritual condition] has passed away. Behold, the fresh and new has come!*

*(2 Cor 5:17 - AMP)*

- “I’m too valuable to be oppressed any longer”

- When man becomes dominated by his circumstances, he becomes **oppressed**;
  1. To keep down by severe and unjust use of force or authority: *a people who were oppressed by tyranny.*
  2. To weigh heavily on: *Poverty oppresses the spirit.*
  3. To overwhelm or crush.
- The goal of ‘oppression’ is a **broken spirit**.
- God has reprogrammed my spirit so that my soul could be **liberated** again.

- “I’m too valuable to think like I used to”

- It's not what you are that holds you back, it's what you think you are not.
- Nothing changes until your mind changes.
- Information does not bring transformation - conversion does.
- The teaching of the word brings revelation, but the transfer of the spirit of that word brings transformation.

*And when God is personally present, a living Spirit, that old, constricting legislation is recognized as obsolete. We're free of it! All of us! Nothing between us and God, our faces shining with the brightness of his face. And so we are transfigured much like the Messiah, our lives gradually becoming brighter and more beautiful as God enters our lives and we become like him.*

*(2 Cor 3:17-18 Message)*
