- “I will never leave you nor forsake you”

So we may boldly say:

“The LORD is my helper; I will not fear.

What can man do to me?” (Heb 13:6 – NKJV)

- God *‘forsook’* Jesus on the cross (Matt. 27:46) so that you and I would ***never be forsaken*** (abandoned or deserted)!

- “I am more than a conqueror through Him who loves me”

None of this fazes us because Jesus loves us. I’m absolutely convinced that nothing—nothing living or dead, angelic or demonic, today or tomorrow, high or low, thinkable or unthinkable—absolutely nothing can get between us and God’s love because of the way that Jesus our Master has embraced us.

(Rom. 8:38-39 - Message)

- A conqueror is both a ***winner*** and a ***victor***.

- “I am a son of God”

You can tell for sure that you are now fully adopted as his own children because God sent the Spirit of his Son into our lives crying out, “Papa! Father!” Doesn’t that privilege of intimate conversation with God make it plain that you are not a slave, but a child? And if you are a child, you’re also an heir, with complete access to the inheritance.

(Gal 4:6-7- Message)

- God singled me out and ***selected me*** for adoption!

- “I am a strong in the Lord & the power of His might”

- I am dressed from head to toe, front to back, with ***God’s whole armour*** (Eph 6:10-20).
- This is the same armour that Jesus overcame the devil with.
- I quench ***every fiery dart*** with the shield of faith.
- As I pray in the Spirit, the enemies plans are exposed.

- “He became poor that I might become rich”

- According to the ***riches of His grace***, I will give my life (my time, talents, and treasure) to build the Kingdom of God.
- I will not adopt a recession mentally, but will be blessed like Isaac ***as I sow*** in a time of famine (Gen. 26:12-14).
