And hewn themselves cisterns—broken cisterns that

• God Reveals Himself as the Source of all Life & Blessing

- God is effectively saying; “I AM the Fountain of Living Waters”
- The Life of GOD is a continual flow coming from His Presence
- Within that river, there is a multiplicity of streams...

⁷ How precious is Your lovingkindness, O God!

*Therefore the children of men put their trust under
the shadow of Your wings.*

*⁸ They are **abundantly satisfied** with the fullness of Your
house,*

*And You give them drink from the **river of Your
pleasures.***

*⁹ For with You is the fountain of life;
In Your light we see light.*

(Psalm 36:7-9)

• God gives us drink from the River of His Pleasures!

- God created us to thirst for Him, therefore He is the only One who can satisfy the deep desires of our heart
- The Lord takes pleasure in the prosperity of his people as we drink from the River of His Pleasures

*13 Jesus answered and said to her, “Whoever drinks of
this water will thirst again, 14 but whoever drinks of the
water that I shall give him will never thirst. But the
water that I shall give him will become in him a fountain
of water **springing up into everlasting life.**”*

(John 4:13-14)

• Jesus came to give us Life and...

- Jesus said that, firstly, He had come to give us Life, (Eternal Life – The God kind of Life)
- But He went on to say that we could have it even more abundantly!
- He left it to us to choose how much of that life that we would drink in!
- Jesus intended for us to drink so much that we would begin to overflow from our heart so that others would be able connect with the True Source!
